GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT



A big Saturday last weekend saw four out of the five Denton Cup matches being played. The Entrance played host to Macquarie in a tough, gritty match in very soggy conditions. After a Tigers try in the first minute, the Scorpions ground their way to the front by half time and held on to win 16-8. Up the road at Bill Hicks Oval, Wyong hosted Kurri after the match was transferred as 'the graveyard' at Kurri Kurri was unplayable due to the weather. Wyong led for most of the match and ran out comfortable winners 26-4. Maitland didn't have it all their own way in their first home match of the season, with Lakes leading 24-20 at one stage, before Maitland clicked in top gear for a 38-24 win. In the Bar TV feature match, Souths registered their first win of the season with a home 40-22 win over Central. In the last match of the round Cessnock defeated the Northern Hawks 34-22, with the match being deemed a forfeit as the Hawks played over the player points cap allowed for Denton Cup.

Although the Easter long weekend is now upon us, the footy doesn't stop. In fact, in a great precursor to the weekend there are three Thursday night Denton Cup matches you can chose to get out to – Wests host their first home match of the season against Wyong (7pm kick off), the Northern Hawks host their third home match in a row with an 8pm kick off against Macquarie and in a coalfields derby there is a big night a ahead with Cessnock hosting Kurri (8pm kick off). Good Friday afternoon sees Lakes travelling to EDSACC to play The Entrance with a 3pm kick off and finally a special Easter Monday contest between Maitland and Souths takes place at Maitland Sportsground.






