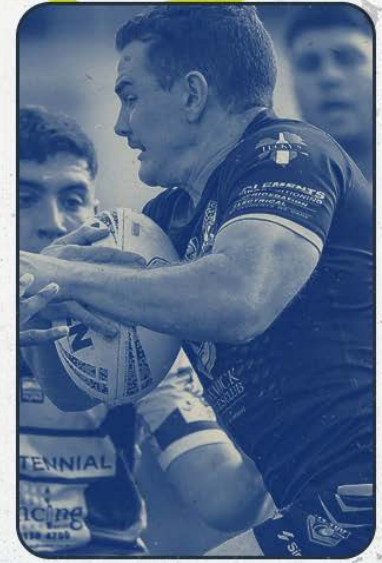

GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT



Last weekend's first match saw a top 5 clash between unbeaten Cessnock who travelled to Toronto to take on the Scorpions. In an unusually high scoring match the Goannas keep their noses in front throughout the match to run out winners 40-30. Elsewhere on Saturday, Kurri put up a good fight against the Rosellas to go down 26-6.

On Sunday, the Tigers travelled to Tomaree to take on the Hawks. It was another strong showing from the visitors who made it three wins on the trot with a 32-10 victory including a double to both Jack Buraston and Toby Key. Maitland travelled to St John and put on another strong performance to win 44-6. Finally, in what was the match of the round, Souths and Lakes traded tries all afternoon at Townson, with the home side squeezing past the visitors 22-20.

This weekend's Round 6 matches suggest there will be some tight contests. With two wins to date the Rosellas take on Lakes, while Macquarie host Central while Kurri travel to South Newcastle. The men's open Country team will be named on Monday morning, so look out for that announcement as there is a good chance players from our victorious Newcastle Rebels will feature strongly.
