

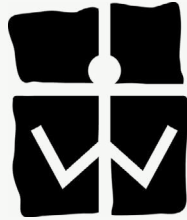

Heading to Harker Oval is never an easy task for an away team taking on Western Suburbs. Credit to our guys who embraced the challenges we set pre game after a mixed performance against Macquarie. Both sides went at it in the early exchanges and after the first 20 minutes we found ourselves down 10 - 6. Once we found an increase in possession flow our guys managed 3 more tries before the break to take a 24 - 6 lead at half time.
