All three clubs also enjoyed success of the field with convincing wins over Macquarie, Kurri Kurri and the Hawks respectively.

We also need to say a big thank you to the players of all grades from Macquarie, Central, Souths and the Hawks who all backed up from Thursdays Anzac Day games to play again on Sunday to played their washed out matches from the week before. The home clubs again emerging victorious in Denton Cup with Macquarie defeating the Hawks and Souths overcoming Central.

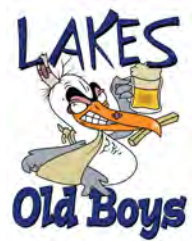

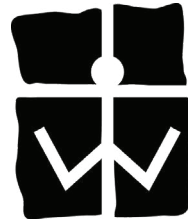
